**RADIOGRAPHIC EVALUATION OF PELVIC PHENOTYPE WITH RESPECT TO HIP DYSPLASIA**

No radiographic evidence of hip dysplasia is present. The consensus evaluation is: GOOD

**EXCELLENT HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

superior hip joint conformation as compared with  
other individuals of the same breed and age

**BORDERLINE HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

marginal hip joint conformation of indeterminate  
status with respect to hip dysplasia at this time --  
Repeat study in six months

**GOOD HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

well formed hip joint conformation as compared  
with other individuals of the same breed and age

**MILD HIP DYSPLASIA**

radiographic evidence of minor dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints

**FAIR HIP JOINT CONFORMATION**

minor irregularities of the hip joint conformation as  
compared with other individuals of the same  
breed and age

**MODERATE HIP DYSPLASIA**

well defined radiographic evidence of dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints

**SEVERE HIP DYSPLASIA**

radiographic evidence of marked dysplastic  
changes of the hip joints
